- 1. Approved February minutes.
- 2. **Select Board** Discussed the airport petition.
- 3. **Treasurers Report** *Robin White* updated the group on the account status.
- 4. **Website** *Stuart Rich* explained that the OH office had uploaded prior minutes to the CC web page; he will handle this process in the future. The group also discussed updates to the website and decided to link to the <u>State of Maine's Wildlife page</u>.
